Finished sizes:

Cradle Quilt: 16" to 18" square

Cradle Pillow: 4" x 5-1/2" Cradle Mattress: 5-1/2" x 16"

You may make the quilt pillow case style or with a binding.

The mattress and pillow can be made from muslin and stuffed with polyester stuffing or batting.


