

Charlotte Hickman made a motion, Penni Simily seconded, to accept the Jan. 9, 2025, minutes as printed in the newsletter. The motion passed.

Treasurer, Lisa Kernaghan, thanked Wendy Holt and Shirley Dunn for performing the audit. They recommended we should have documented proof that online items were received. Changes to the by-laws about documentation requests will be sent to the by-laws and procedures committee. The treasurer's report as published in the newsletter will be filed for audit

#### REQUIREMENTS:

Quilt MUST have a sleeve opening of 4" or bigger

Quilt MUST have a label on the bottom RIGHT side of BACK of quilt (See diagram below)

Label MUST, at least, have the quilt name and your name

Label MAY be temporary (pinned on, on paper, etc...)




