Sierra Mountain Quilters Association General Membership Meeting Minutes June 3, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Penni Simily. There were 25 members present on Zoom. Penni welcomed the members.

Laura Gonzalez made a motion, seconded by Rhonda Lloyd, to accept the May 6, 2021, minutes as printed in the Newsletter. The motion carried.

The April Treasurer's Report was accepted as published in the June newsletter and filed for audit.

Laura Gonzalez and Helen Brown, First Vice Presidents, announced that they have workshops scheduled for October (John Egbert), November (Rachel Clark) and December (Christmas party). They have spoken with Patsy Carpenter about doing a paper piecing workshop, and they are looking for teachers for other things. Penni Simily suggested ice dying; and Laura said she would pursue that. Helen noted that signups for John Egbert's class will be offered to those who previously signed up before it is opened to the membership. Discussion was held relative to the July meeting and status of being able to use the Oakhurst Community Center and their rate increase. Wendy Holt noted that we will need to do our own setup.

Patty Cramer and Maria Ciccarelli, Second Vice Presidents, promoted the positivity challenge – a 16-inch block or smaller depicting something positive from 2020, and due in August – information will be on the website. They are looking at the possibility of a shop hop trip later in the year.

Penni Simily for Teri De La Torre, Membership, reported there are two paid renewals. The fall retreat is scheduled for September 13-16, 2021, at ECCO, and Teri will start taking deposits in July.

We are doing a great job, despite the challenges on distribution. We have over three hundred items distributed, including about 88 quilts. Great Job everyone.


