Supply List for

"Grand Convergence"

Instructor: Mr. John Egbert

Book: "Convergence Quilts" by Ricky Tim's. (Optional but recommended)

Supplies Needed:

- Rotary Cutter with new blade.
- Rotary Cutting mat 18"x 24" or you may use the mats at class if available.
- Sewing machine in good working order.
- Please bring a 1/4" foot AND an open toe foot for your machine.
- Usual rulers for squaring up fabric and cutting strips.
- I use a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and a 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Creative Grids ruler for squaring up fabric.
- 6 1/2" x 24 1/2 " Ruler.
- All usual sewing supplies.
- Pins for piecing.
- Aurifil 50wt. Thread for piecing.
- Marking pen or Frixion pen.
- I will be providing the freezer paper for everyone.

Fabric requirements:

In the book the project calls for 24x36 fabric pieces. This is a bit large so I will be using the 18x24 size fabrics.

- You will need (4) one/half yard cuts of coordinating fabrics

- Please select **contrasting** but coordinating fabrics. Prints, batiks and or solids can be used. You will need extra fabric for the borders.

Please have your fabrics cut and pressed before class, a light starch of your choice is recommended.

*I will have lots of fabric kits available for purchase at the trunk show and in class. (These kits include 3 one/half yard cuts and 1 one yard cut of fabric.)

You can get the kits for \$15 and if you buy 2 you can get a bonus kit for free.
